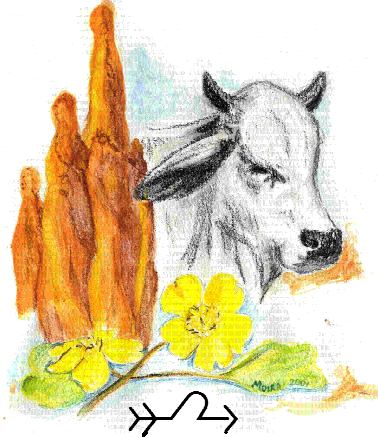

Preparations

The cattle have been run under commercial conditions at Numul Numul station on native pasture. Due to the extended wet season and delays in accessibility no buffalo fly treatment had been done; minimal mineral lick had been able to be got to them.; and they have only been able to be processed and assessed for the Auction in early May. Whilst in the yards for sale and preparation they have been on NFC hay cubes.

All animals have been inoculated for Botulinum using Pfizer Longrange 1 year vaccination. Paramax pour on has been used in the week prior to sale ready for clearance dipping if moving out of the tick zone.

Semen Evaluation










The bulls have been semen tested sounded by Moira Lanzarin (trained by Alf Turner, NT Artificial Breeding Services). This involves crush side examination of testicle shape, texture, circumference , length and epididymis; internal palpation and check of seminal vesicles and collection of sperm to determine semen motility and semen morphology (abnormalities).

Shown in the catalogue is the scrotal circumference and percent normal sperm . Minimum standards as per Australian Bull Breeding Guidelines for *Bos Indicus* are 28cm for a 2 year old bull, 32cm for a 3 year old bull and 60% normal sperm.

At Coodardie we consider good scrotal length and predominate epididymis more important than scrotal circumference alone.

The bulls are guaranteed fertile for 12 months as per conditions of sale (page 26). It is recommended that bulls be retested every one or two years to ensure optimal performance. More detailed results are available on request.

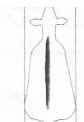
CLMS Evaluation (Classic Rating)

Scoring: 1 is best, 5 is worst (3 is acceptable)

All lots have been assessed by independent livestock consultant, Gerald Wyatt of Classic Livestock Management Services (CLMS) on Breeding Traits, Beef traits and temperament. This information is recorded in the pictorial summary for each bull lot (see example on previous page). Classic ratings above average are highlighted. The heifers have been fully assessed and their information will be available to those interested. Their tenderness rating is painted on their shoulder and a good rating is denoted by a red star.



★ **Tenderness** is closely linked to fertility and therefore considered the most important trait, or a base from which to work. The flatter (or more concave) the bone (felt on the jaw bone) the more tender the meat. A red star denotes flat bone (1,2,3).



Hormonal activity: Directly related to palatability (taste) and fertility—determined by greasy spine, teat assessment, prominence of hair swirls and the softness of the skin. All of these are controlled by the pituitary gland.



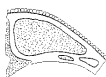
Escutcheon: Milk quantity and ability to continue lactating whilst pregnant. I.e. produce higher weight weaners. This is determined by the size and shape of the escutcheon (the hair patterns from under the tail to teats).



Milk quality is determined by the presence of fine, soft hair, yellowish skin and small fatty like scales between the legs, in the tail swish and in the ears.



Breed Traits: This is a summary classification of basic form, body shape, angularity, body length, depth, femininity, calving capacity, udder, teats, calving capabilities and reproductive capacity.



Meat Traits: This is a summary classification of head shape/muzzle; eye muscle, front end – neck/shoulders/chine, rear end – rump/hips/leg angle, muscle shape and fat cover.



Temperament: Separates animals from the same management group on their calmness in a confined area at the time of assessment. Animals which are extremely quiet (ie. Responses positively to touch) score “1”. Animals that are aggressive or extremely agitated in the crush are scored “5”.

Classic Livestock Management Services is a relatively new company, set up to develop a grading system for live animals that will produce consistent, quality products and support and encourage the production of livestock using a holistic approach that will lead to an increase in real productivity and sustainability for the industry.

The company's aim is to develop a more universally acceptable method of livestock evaluation that will guarantee quality for consumers.

CLMS have developed an evaluation system that is capable of delivering in excess of a 98% success rate consistently with cattle for high meat quality.

We have identified 18 key confirmation traits that can be visually and kinaesthetically assessed and scored by trained evaluators. These traits concentrate on selecting for breeding purposes i.e. maternal traits, and for meat and milk quality.

The two key areas that we know from consumer feedback to be the most critical for eating quality are a consistency of tenderness and palatability. Interestingly these two characteristics are linked to better herd fertility and higher in essential and healthy unsaturated fats. A win-win all round.

The major advantage of the CLMS system is that it has the capability to select animals on the hoof in a matter of minutes or less, as compared with other meat grading systems that primarily grade after slaughter.

We have established that the required traits can be found in all breeds, although some of the older, less popular breeds tend to have a higher percentage of better grading animals. We think that the popular breeds have been more genetically manipulated in recent years to produce highly only in one or two areas e.g. growth rates and milk quantity.

Stud History

Coodardie Brahman stud was formed in 1976 in north Queensland by Mike and Rory O'Brien (MJ and RS O'Brien). From modest beginnings the stud herd grew to a strength of in excess of 1500 registered breeding cows. This was boosted by the largest single stud purchase in Australia – 600 Cherokee stud cows at \$3000 each in 1991.

Coodardie led the way in single stud annual production sales in Charters Towers, north Queensland in 1991 to 1993, as well as holding their own sale in Katherine, Northern Territory in 1990. In 1993 the O'Briens sold their Queensland properties and moved to Carmor Plains Station, NT, taking with them 2500 head of their Coodardie Brahmans.

Coodardie Brahmans is a stud and commercial Brahman cattle operation based at Numul Numul and Coodardie Stations near Mataranka in the Northern Territory. Coodardie Brahmans is the trading name of Coodardie Pty Ltd which is owned and operated by the O'Brien family.

In November 2001 the family sold their NT floodplain station, Carmor Plains, and moved their entire operation, which includes 3000 high quality Brahman cattle, to Numul Numul Station south east of Mataranka. It was at this time at which Coodardie Pty Ltd was formed. Numul Numul is leased from the local Numul Numul Aboriginal Corporation. In 2003, a smaller property, "Coodardie" was formed on the outskirts of Mataranka. It is the home of the core stud herd.

IMPORTANT NOTICE

All bids shall be treated as offers made upon the following Terms and Conditions of Sale and all persons present are admitted to attend the sale on the basis that they have notice of these Terms and Conditions.

1. The highest bidder shall, subject to Condition 2, be the purchaser provided that the vendor reserves the right to bid either by himself or through his agent or auctioneer and should any dispute arise among the bidders for any lot, during or immediately after sale of the lot, it shall be settled at the auctioneers absolute discretion who may, should one of the disputants advance, put the lot or lots up again. The bidding from time to time shall be regulated by the auctioneer and no bid shall be retracted.
2. The sale will be conducted on a "Sale" or "No Sale" basis whereby the lot for sale shall be knocked down to the highest bidder, but the sale will be subject to the acceptance of the highest bid by the vendor who will immediately after the fall of the hammer declare "Sale" or "No Sale". 7. In the event of any dispute in respect to the sale of any lot:-

17.2 FEMALES. Save and except for female calves at foot, all females are guaranteed to be in calf or go into calf within six months of the date of sale or by the age of 30 months whichever date shall be the later.

A positive pregnancy test certified by a qualified veterinary surgeon shall be sufficient evidence that the animal is in calf.

17.3 Claims under Clauses 17.1 and 17.2 guarantees of fertility shall be made to the vendor within six months from the date of sale or prior to the animal entering a quarantine area other than on the vendor's property.

17.3.1 All claims must be accompanied by a veterinary certificate which shall clearly identify the basis of the claim.

17.3.2 Infertility resulting from injury or disease occurring after the sale of the animal shall not be covered by this guarantee.

17.3.3 The vendor retains the right to have the animal placed on a property nominated by him or returned to his own property for further assessment of fertility for a period not exceeding six months. In the event of the animal being proven fertile within the period, the costs incurred shall be borne by the purchaser. In the event

of the animal not being proven fertile within the period the costs incurred shall be borne by the vendor.

17.4 **LIABILITY OF A VENDOR.** Except for costs defined elsewhere in the conditions of sale, the liability of a vendor in respect of claims relating to fertility shall not exceed the purchase price of the animal (s) or to provide mutually agreed upon replacement animals.

17.5 **REFUNDS.** In the event of a claim being substantiated and the purchase price being refunded, the animal/s shall automatically become the property of the vendor and be returned to him or disposed of according to his instructions at his expense.

17.6 This guarantee shall be voided by the purchaser if -

(a) The animal is returned to the vendor -

(i) in poor physical condition or with any injury;

(ii) tests carried out on behalf of the vendor within fourteen days of such return proved positive to any diseases which may affect the animals fertility or ability to breed naturally; or

(b) the purchaser has collected and stored semen from a bull or embryos from a female.

17.7 In the event of a dispute as to whether a lot is a breeder, such dispute shall be resolved by the vendor and the purchaser and the auctioneer, while he will use his best endeavours to assist, shall have no liability or responsibility in that regard. In the event that a lot is alleged or proved not to be a breeder, the purchaser shall nevertheless be obliged to pay the auctioneer the full purchase price and any other monies or interest payable by the purchaser in accordance with these Terms and Conditions.
